#### <u>1 step with 4 critical elements</u> (3-4 yrs)

Use people, animals, attributes – size (big, little), feelings (happy, sad), colors, shapes, location

- 1. Find the girl eating a banana under the tree
- 2. Find the happy boy eating an ice cream
- 3. Find the circle on the blue square
- 4. Find the mom driving a blue car
- 5. Find the big black dog in the box
